World Heritage Day Lecture 2020

The Centre for Faith Enrichment and the Archives Office of the Archdiocese of Perth are pleased to bring you the third annual World Heritage Day Lecture series from within the St Mary's Cathedral precinct.

The conference will feature a keynote presentation from Foreign Editor at The Australian and author of God is Good for You, Greg Sheridan. Senior lecturer at University of Aberdeen, Dr Colin Barr and Senior lecturer at Queensland University of Technology, Dr Alex Deagon, will also be speaking.

Topics covered include the role which the Judeo-Christian tradition has played and continues to play in Australian culture, the impact that technology is having on religion, and the legacy of the Irish spiritual Empire in the English speaking world.

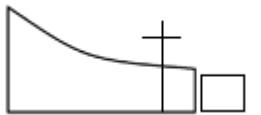
